



Baby Bee lovey

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This is my Bee lovey pattern. It's so adorable and easy for a child to hold and carry. This crocheted baby comforter will help the child feel secure and beloved. And makes for some super cute baby photos! It's made with a super soft chenille yarn and cotton yarn.

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Pattern info

The Bee is crocheted in two parts. The body as one part and the wings as one.

The body is made by using yellow and black cotton yarn and yellow chenille yarn.

Please read the whole pattern before starting to make sure you understand how the item is made and if there are anything to consider before starting.

Materials

Yarn:

- Yellow cotton yarn (sport or DK)
- Black cotton yarn (sport or DK)
- Yellow chenille yarn (chunky/bulky)
- White chenille yarn (chunky/bulky, for wings)
- 2.5 mm (US B/1) for cotton yarn
- 3.5 mm (US E/4) for chenille body
- 6.0 mm (US J/10) for chenille wings

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- Black embroidery thread (for eyes)
- Toy stuffing
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

Gauge

Gauge is not critical, but stitches should be tight enough to prevent stuffing from showing.

Finished Measurements

Approximately 16–20 cm (6.5–8 in) long, depending on yarn used and tension.

Abbreviations and Special Stitches

- ch: chain
 - sc: single crochet
 - hdc: half double crochet
 - sc inc: 2 sc in same stitch
 - hdc inc: 2 hdc in same stitch
 - sc2tog: single crochet 2 together
 - hdc2tog: half double crochet 2 together
 - st(s): stitch(es)
 - mr: magic ring
 - sl st: slip stitch
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Pattern Notes

- Body is worked in continuous rounds unless otherwise stated. Use a stitch marker for the first st of each round.
 - Color and hook changes are noted in pattern.
 - Wings are made separately and sewn on.
 - Chenille sections are softer and fluffier, making the bee extra cuddly!
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Body

Start with yellow cotton yarn and a 2.5 mm crochet hook.

Round 1: 6 sc in mr (6 sts)

Round 2: [sc inc] x 6 (12 sts)

Round 3: [1 sc, sc inc] x 6 (18 sts) **Round 4:** [2

sc, sc inc] x 6 (24 sts) **Round 5:** [3 sc, sc inc] x

6 (30 sts) **Round 6:** [4 sc, sc inc] x 6 (36 sts)

Round 7: [5 sc, sc inc] x 6 (42 sts)

Round 8: 42 sc (42 sts)

Round 9: [6 sc, sc inc] x 6 (48 sts)

Round 10–17: 48 sc (48 sts) {8 rounds}

Round 18: [6 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (42 sts) **Round 19:**

[5 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (36 sts) **Round 20:** [4 sc,

sc2tog] x 6 (30 sts) **Round 21:** [3 sc, sc2tog] x 6

(24 sts) **Round 22:** [2 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (18 sts)

Stuff the head firmly. For secure eyes, embroider them now and fasten all ends inside.

Change to yellow chenille yarn and a 3.5 mm crochet hook.

Round 23–27: 18 sc (18 sts) {5 rounds}

Round 28: [1 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (12 sts)

Switch to yellow and black cotton yarn and a 2.5 mm hook for stripes.

Round 29: With yellow, [1 sc, sc inc] x 6 (18 sts)

Round 30: With yellow, [2 sc, sc inc] x 6 (24 sts)

Round 31: With black, 24 sc (24 sts)

Round 32: With yellow, 24 sc (24 sts)

Round 33–34: With black, 24 sc (24 sts) {2 rounds}

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Round 35: With yellow, 24 sc (24 sts)

Round 36: With black, 24 sc (24 sts)

Round 37: With black, [2 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (18 sts) **Round 38–**

39: With yellow, 18 sc (18 sts) {2 rounds} Stuff the body before closing.

Round 40: 18 sc (18 sts)

Round 41: [1 sc, sc2tog] x 6 (12 sts)

Round 42: 12 sc (12 sts)

Round 43: [sc2tog] x 6 (6 sts)

Round 44: 6 sc (6 sts)

Fasten off, sew the hole closed, and secure all ends.

Wings (Make 2)

With white chenille yarn and a 6.0 mm crochet hook.

Round 1: 6 hdc in mr, sl st to first st, ch 1 (6 sts)

Round 2: [hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (12 sts)

Round 3: [1 hdc, hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (18 sts) **Round 4:** [2

hdc, hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (24 sts)

Round 5–8: 24 hdc, sl st to first st, ch 1 (24 sts) {4 rounds}

Round 9: [2 hdc, hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (18 sts)

Round 10: [1 hdc, hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (12 sts)

Round 11: [hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (6 sts)

Round 12–13: 6 hdc, sl st to first st, ch 1 (6 sts) {2 rounds}

Round 14: [hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (12 sts)

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Round 15: [1 hdc, hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (18 sts) **Round 16:** [2

hdc, hdc inc] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (24 sts)

Round 17–20: 24 hdc, sl st to first st, ch 1 (24 sts) {4 rounds}

Round 21: [2 hdc, hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (18 sts)

Round 22: [1 hdc, hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (12 sts)

Round 23: [hdc2tog] x 6, sl st to first st, ch 1 (6 sts)

Fasten off and sew the hole closed. Weave in all ends.

Assembly

- Sew the narrow middle part of each wing to the yellow chenille section on the back of the bee.
- Embroider eyes using black thread if you have not already done so.
- Weave in and secure all the remaining yarn ends.
